PACIFIC ISLANDERS' CULTURAL ASSOCIATION (PICA) EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

AREA OF STUDY: Any Major: Higher Education, Professional or Trade School

SCHOLARSHIP: \$1,000 for 2024-2025

DEADLINE: Application and accompanying documents must be delivered by email to

picascholarships@gmail.com no later than June 30, 2024.

AWARD DATE: Sunday, August 11, 2024

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Preference is given to applicants of Pacific Islander descent (Polynesian, Melanesian, or Micronesian).

- 2. The applicant's home of residence must be within one of these California counties: Alameda, Contra Costa, Fresno, Marin, Monterey, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Sonoma, or within those counties' boundaries.
- 3. Applicant must be sponsored by a community leader who has worked with you as a student, volunteer, or mentor*.
- 4. Applicant must have graduated from High School or obtained a GED prior to the AWARD DATE above.
- 5. Recipients must enroll in and maintain at least 12 units each quarter or semester during the academic year listed above at a Community College; four-year College or University; Trade or Professional School.
- 6. A maximum of four scholarships may be awarded during an applicant's post-high school career.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Completed scholarship application.
- 2. Transcripts from last year of high school or current post-high school term.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation (one must be from your community leader sponsor).
- 4. Copy of current class schedule or school registration for current term (last current schedule or completed classes is acceptable).
- 5. On **one page** in at least 12-point font, please state:
 - a. Financial need
 - b. Educational goals
 - c. Career objectives
 - d. Ethnic background
 - e. Your cultural ties to the community
 - f. Community service
 - g. Why you think you should be awarded this scholarship
- 6. Interviews may be required of scholarship finalists and may be held in a location in the San Francisco, East Bay, or South Bay areas.
- 7. Have your **sponsor** reply to the following questions in at least 12-point font (1-page maximum):
 - a. What is your relationship to the applicant and how long have you known him/her?
 - b. Please describe why this applicant would be a good candidate for this award.
- 8. Please include a current color photo.

^{*} For example: the sponsor may be an individual, school administrator, Kumu Hula of an active halau, or President or leader of a Pacific Islander-related organization.
